Quick-Paint Prospectus

When: Saturday May 21, 2016

Register: Bring your blank or toned canvas or preferred substrate to The Old Courthouse Arts Center between 8am – 1:30pm. We will stamp your canvas on the back and register your time. REGISTRATION CLOSES PROMPTLY at 1:30pm.

Paint: Plan to paint on the square or in close proximity to the Old Courthouse Arts Center.

You will have 2½ hours to create your work, sign, frame and securely wire your painting for hanging.

For example, if you have your canvas stamped at 11:00am, you must have your work in by 1:30pm.

Deliver Work: Deliver signed, framed and wired painting to The Old Courthouse Arts Center **no later than 4pm.** Only one painting may be submitted.

Eligibility & Rules All painting mediums (No photography)

Reference photographs may NOT be used

Paintings eligible for quick-paint award *must* have the quick-paint stamp on back of canvas. Watercolor and pastel artists should plan to make stamp visible.

Works should be no larger than 16 x20" unframed and 22 x26" framed.

Sketches created in a sketchbook prior to the morning of the event ARE allowed.

Awards will be presented on the night of the gala reception, May 28, 6:00-8:00pm.

The quick-paint paintings will be on exhibit and for sale along with paintings from the main event for the month of June.

All works must be for sale. The Old Courthouse Arts Center will retain 20% of all work sold. All work must be properly framed.

No saw-tooth hangers, stained mats, gallery wrapped canvas.
